

**PCRC 2010**  
**RACE COURSE BOARD RECOMMENDATIONS**

The combination of race courses available for 2009 are as follows. The first letter is for the spinnaker boats; the second letter is for the non-spinnaker boats.

Two courses must be posted on the course board. The top letter is for the spinnaker fleet; the bottom letter is for the non-spinnaker A and B fleets. The Race Committee should consider the conditions and choose a course combination that is appropriate, see below. The course boards match the various combinations and are located in the white dock box on the Race Committee Stand. One you select the course combination for the race, place the board in the stand provided on the right side of the Stand. After all boats have started, replace the course board in the box.

**Very Light Air (less than 5kts)**

C – A	3.3 – 2.3
E – C	3.4 – 3.3
G – B	4.5 – 2.9
H – D	4.7 – 3.4
I – F	4.7 – 4.4

**Light Air (5-8 kts)**

L – F	5.5 – 4.4
L – E	5.5 – 3.4
M – H	5.5 – 4.7
N – I	5.6 – 4.7

**Moderate Air (9-13 kts)**

P – I	6.1 – 4.7
Q – J	6.4 – 5.3
R – M	6.5 – 5.5
S – O	7.4 – 5.8
S – L	7.4 – 5.5

**Strong Air (Greater than 14 kts)**

T – R	7.9 – 6.5
U – T	8.0 – 7.9
V – J	8.1 – 5.3
W – O	8.5 – 5.8
